The City of Folkston held a public hearing for the 2021 millage rate and 2022 Budget on October 7, 2021 at 6:00 P.M. at City Hall.

City Manager, Mr. Lloyd opened the Public Hearing at 6:00 P.M.

Pastor Terrance Pender and Tammy King asked how much the millage rate will increase.

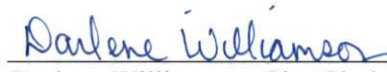
Mr. Lloyd stated the millage rate will increase from 7.401 to 8.114 mills; the increase is 0.713 mills. For a home with a fair market value of \$75,000.00 the increase will be approximately \$21.39 and for a non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$50,000.00 the increase will be approximately \$14.26. This increase will generate approximately \$51,000.00. The 2022 budget includes two additional police officers and two additional public works employees.

Tammy King requested a copy of the 2022 budget. Mr. Lloyd explained the budget process by departments and gave Ms. King a copy.

Mr. Lloyd closed the Public Hearing at 6:30 P.M.
